In Wyoming it is against the law for us to hold daily classes for a home school student. We can offer individual classes similar to what we do in the evenings from time to time, but we cannot become the student's technology teacher. See statute 2-4-101 (a)(v).

We can make hands on projects available for students to work through with their parents, and can make some of our regular programming during the daytime hours if enough students are interested (same fee structure as with evening classes).

Home school students will be assigned a storage bin for holding projects from day to day and some kits and parts can be checked out week to week, but cannot leave the building.

Home school families can find their own projects and content, but leverage our equipment on their own time

If there were a large enough group of monthly home school family memberships, we will develop content based on requested specific new topics (with projects, instructions, and materials)

For an additional fee, projects could be developed based around a specific requested topic. Fee would be dependent on topic, equipment and skills needed to create the project.
